

SPECIAL ATTRACTIONS

The definition of a Special Attraction varies from presenter to presenter. To us, a Special Attraction is any unique project that defies a single genre description.

The Accidental Hero tells the real-life story of Matt Konop. A young soldier who left a Wisconsin farm only to discover his own identity a world away in the Czech villages of his grandparents. This multimedia, one-man show is written and performed by Patrick Dewane who wrote the show after discovering his grandfather's hidden archive of diaries, photos, and film footage. The show traces his grandfather's journey from Omaha Beach and the Battle of the Bulge to the end of WWII and the Czech villagers who embraced him as their own.

An unusual hybrid of vaudeville, circus, and sideshow with a dash of burlesque, **Bindlestiff Family Cirkus** gives a contemporary twist to the grand traditions of American circus. **Bindlestiff Family Cirkus** offers hands-on learning where students, of all ages, can learn to juggle, clown around, ride a unicycle, march on stilts, or build a human pyramid.

Blind Visionaries by jazz composer **Daniel Kelly** in collaboration with **The Seeing With Photography Collective** is a multimedia concert that explores the nature of sight and blindness, light and dark, and what it really means to see. Through the lens of blind photographers and live music inspired by their beautiful and thought-provoking images, audiences are invited to see and hear the world in a new way.

Makin' Cake by poet and change agent **Dasha Kelly Hamilton** explores culture, class, and race through the history of cake and its many layers that have influenced the making of America. **Makin' Cake** is a 50-minute performance followed by a Community Conversation and Cake Reception.

The Music of Laurel Canyon by Buffalo Rome celebrates one of the most sacred musical places in the '60s and early '70s. Sitting above the Sunset Strip, Laurel Canyon became a nest of creativity, immortalizing artists like Joni Mitchell, Buffalo Springfield, Crosby, Stills, Nash & Young and The Mamas and the Papas, who called the neighborhood home.

Sonic Butterfly, by installation artist musician **Andrea Brook**, transforms indoor and outdoor spaces—theaters, buildings, and natural environments—into a stunning, immersive instrument using a 26-string acoustic, chromatic, long-string harp. What an amazing way to invite audiences into your venue by surrounding them in the sound and energy of **Sonic Butterfly**.

Darrah Carr Dance is a high energy company comprised of four musicians and six championship dancers including Trent Kowalk, Tony Award® winner and the original star of **Billy Elliot** and Timothy Kochka, two-time World Irish Dance Champion, and former member of **Riverdance**. Shows include **Ceilidh: An Evening of Irish Music** and **Dance; Baile: A Celtic Christmas Celebration** and **Dancing the Great Arc**, based on the concept album by Dana Lyn and Kyle Sanna.

MUSIC

As the musical force behind **Cerqua Rivera Dance Theatre**, we are thrilled to offer the **Joe Cerqua Band** as a separate ensemble for touring. This high-octane, 9-piece jazz band, led by award-winning composer Joe Cerqua, is comprised of a who's who of Chicago's finest musicians. *New City* calls the band, "positively intoxicating."

Neely Bruce is one of America's most prolific composers with more than 800 completed works. As a pianist and scholar of American music, he shares funny stories and performs virtuoso musical examples in **Short Stories at the Piano**. In **Museum Concerts**, Neely performs works from composers, known and unknown, that relate to a Permanent Collection or Current Exhibition.

Jazz pianist and composer **Daniel Kelly** explores the intersection of music with literature, visual art, and journalism. In **All the World's a Song: Shakespeare in Jazz**, Kelly interprets Shakespeare's works into fresh and dynamic jazz songs that have enthusiastic audiences of all ages singing along.

In true *Classic Meets Cool* style, pianist **Barron Ryan** performs original compositions and arrangements that combine classical music forms with pop, funk, and jazz. His album, *First Of Its Kind*, continues his musical adventure that draws inspiration from Mozart to Michael Jackson. Named one of "Ten Innovators to Watch in 2021" by *Smithsonian Magazine*. Barron Ryan cannot be confined.

As part of the renowned piano duo **Ryan & Ryan**, Barron joins with his music mentor and father, Donald Ryan. Donald is a master of diverse styles as evidenced by a diploma from the 9th International Chopin Competition, induction into the Oklahoma Jazz Hall of Fame, and the distinction of being a Steinway Artist. Their programs, **Kickin'** the Clouds Away, Going Gershwin and Merry & Bright: Songs of Christmas Cheer are pure joy. To sum it up, they make irresistible music that inspires.

Inspired by traditional Japanese drumming, **San Jose Taiko** expresses the beauty of the human spirit through the creative expression, and rhythmic heartbeat of the taiko. **San Jose Taiko** encourages cultural pluralism as a gateway to better communication, connection, open-mindedness, and social justice.

Mads Tolling & The Mads Men takes us back with *Playing the 60s* serving up fun-filled nostalgia, new arrangements of familiar tunes and fresh takes on jazz standards and the not-so-standard, pushing the boundaries of where the violin can go. In *Cool Yule:* A *Nordic Holiday Celebration*, Mads performs a jazzy take on the holiday traditions of his homeland in Denmark.





MUSIC

If award-winning Americana, Bluegrass, folk and nostalgia are near and dear to your heart, you'll want to know about **Bettman & Halpin**, **Bobby Horton**, **Buffalo Rome**, **Michael J. Miles**, **Three On A String** and **Tim Farrell**.

Bettman & Halpin performs a fresh, yet enduring combination of Americana, folk, and Bluegrass. The perfect blending of Stephanie Bettman's angelic voice and exquisite fiddle playing with Luke Halpin's adept musicality on mandolin, fiddle, and banjo results in a powerful chemistry. In their latest album, *Timeless*, their chemistry is an undeniable in this beautiful tribute to the American Songbook.

Bobby Horton shares the touching songs and heartfelt stories of the Civil War and the people who lived through our country's most turbulent time in **Songs and Stories** of the Civil War. He shares the influence of westward expansion and the development of the railroads on American culture in **The Long Steel Rail in America**. As a composer of original period music, Bobby has worked with filmmaker Ken Burns on a variety of projects including Civil War, Baseball, Country Music and Benjamin Franklin.

Buffalo Rome celebrates *The Music of Laurel Canyon* with their rich and warm vocal harmonies as an acoustic show or as a larger show accompanied by piano, bass and drums. Lovingly referred to as "Crosby, Stills and Nashville," **Buffalo Rome** blends the earthy feel reminiscent of the 1970's west coast country rock sense with today's modern country.

Imagine Bach on a 5-string banjo, the sweaty blues of the 1930s and the inspired folk music of Bob Dylan. **Michael J. Miles** combines his love of poetry, politics, history, and music in his critically acclaimed performances that explore themes of protest, patriotism, change and what it means to be an American. Michael was honored to see his **Mississippi River Suite** reach #9 on the national folk music charts.

Three On A String has been laughing and playing together for more than half a century entertaining audiences with their special blend of Bluegrass, Country and Old Time infused with side-splitting comedy. Inductees of the Alabama Music Hall of Fame, **Three On A String** is a musical joyride suitable for the entire family.

Tim Farrell is one of only four musicians in the world to be named one of the 100 Greatest Acoustic Guitarist who have also won Best Instrumental in the International Acoustic Music Award. His fingerstyle guitar playing, and original compositions display an elegant simplicity that celebrates the purity of the acoustic guitar. As part of the trio, StringSongs, he collaborates with bassist Michael Manring and Christopher Garcia in The Beatles Reimagined, a captivating evening of pop, jazz, fusion, folk, and world music influences.

Jade Solomon Curtis invites us to deeply explore our human and societal constructs in Black Like Me: An Exploration of the Word Nigger. Her new work, Keeper of Sadness, illuminates the countless contributions that Black women have made to ensure the livelihood of others and delves into the profound and lasting impact of transgenerational trauma and pervasive stereotypes.

Michael J. Miles commissioned work *Mississippi River Suite* uses the mighty river as a metaphor for a nation divided. In this musical portrait, Michael explores history in real time, inclusion, exclusion, race, politics and how we can work together to meet in the middle.

In **San Jose Taiko Swingposium** the taiko ensemble performs with your local big band for a program that brings awareness to the Japanese American experience from WW II to
